## Scale Competition August 8<sup>th</sup> 2010 JUDGING CRITERIA

Models will be split into two sections, scratch built and ARTF. Scratch built models can enter in both the STATIC and FLYING sections. ARTF models can enter in the FLYING section only.

Members are encouraged to bring as many models as they wish to help make the day as interesting as possible. However to keep judging time reasonable they can only nominate one model to be judged in each section. The same scratch built model can of course be entered into both sections.

### STATIC COMPETITION

Models will be judged on the following criteria and points awarded up to the maximums shown:

Overall finish	10 points
Detail applied	10 points
Build Quality	10 points
Stand-off realism	10 points

The total points achieved will then be multiplied by the following factors depending upon the origin of the model.

Designed and built from scratch	x1.5
Built from commercial plans	x1.2
Built from a kit	x1.0
Part built - finished only by entrant	x0.75

A model not built by the entrant will be deemed ARTF even if it is built from plans etc by third party.

### FLYING COMPETITION

All models will be judged for their realism with which they fly. The models should be flown as the full size would be expected to fly and only perform manoeuvres that the full size would be capable of. This will be a subjective assessment by the judges and a maximum of 20 points will be available. Flying time will be limited – to be determined on the day dependant upon number of entrants.
